Your Consultant or Manager will be advised that you cannot undertake Exposure Prone Procedures (EPP) until all the requisite information has been received. If you are aware that you have any infectious disease or other health related condition that may impact upon your work, you have a responsibility to discuss these with the Occupational Health Professional.
